E-Government

- E-government = electronization of public administration
- E-government is using informatic technologies of public institution to secure information exchange of citizens.



The goal of E-Government

- faster
- more reliable
- and cheaper provision of government services general public



Four basic registers:

- 1) Citizens' register – there are given records about citizens of the Czech Republic and foreigners with a residence in the Cz.R.
- 2) Person register – information about companies, entrepreneurs...



3) Property register – information about addresses, buildings and land

4) Register of laws and duties – basic overview of administration



CZECH POINT



= central register of public administration

(1st July 2012)



- citizens needn't give reference data again and again



CZECH POINT

- a contact place of public administration
- in one place, it enables to get or to give statements or application



In Czech Point, you can:

- **get the information kept about you or your company**
- **get the information who wanted to see the details of your company**
- **change your personal data or information about your company**



- In order to gain some information, you have to prove your identity
- Fee for one page is no more than 100 crowns



- The service is efficient especially for citizens and entrepreneurs
- They can faster deal with their requests
- They don't have to repeatedly fill in their identification data



- They have an overview of their data
- These data are „stored“ in one place and are updated when necessary
- For example: a change of residence is „reported“ to state administration authorities and other chosen entities (bank, ensurance company, electricity supplier etc.)



- The state has to inform the citizen and the entrepreneur about all the accesses to their personal data (they get the automatic statement to their data box)



Date box

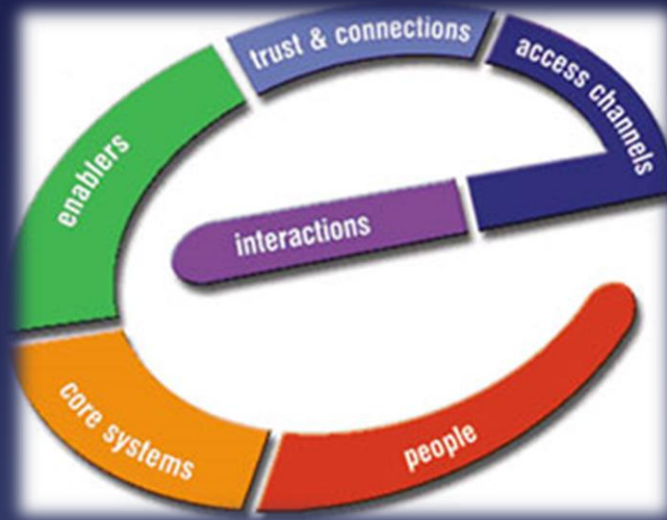
- revolutionary principle of communication state management and public authorities in the form of an electronic storage





With this service you can be alerted of incoming messages in your mailbox data via SMS.

At the same time, the SMS message, you can be alerted to incoming messages that type into their own hands.



- statements sent via data box are free of charge
- the form for application is accessible on <http://portal.gov.cz/portal/obcan/>
- the statement is sent back to the data box of the sender
