- **Austria**: project BLOG completed; link to be sent to the Czech coordinator to be made public on the project website
- **Czech Republic**: website (deadline: 15th December 2015)
- **Austria**: questionnaire to be sent to other schools (deadline: 10th December, 2015)
- **Sweden**: Google Drive (deadline: 5th December, 2015)
- **Sweden**: Facebook page (deadline: 5th December, 2015)
 - ✓ Swedish partner will make teachers from other countries so-called administrators and these teachers will be responsible for inviting the students and other people to participate in the discussions

3) Next project meetings

2nd Project Meeting in Amstetten, Austria

- <u>Date</u>: 8th 12th February, 2016 (2-3 working days), participating schools will check the flights and then Austria will specify the exact working days (*deadline*: 31st December, 2015)
- 4 students, 2 teachers from each country
- <u>Topic</u>: "Specific of starting a business in the partner countries" and "Social entrepreneurship in each country with examples of good practice"
- <u>Tasks</u>: students of each country prepare a presentation (Austrian school will prepare a guideline what to include in the presentation and they will send the guideline to other schools *deadline*: 10th December, 2015)

Programme of the meeting:

- partners' presentations on the topic "Specific of starting a business…"
- workshop (international groups) discussing the best conditions for starting a business
- partners' presentations or videos (each school will find and interview a representative of social entrepreneurship (= non-profitable company) in their country)
- a trip to Vienna (sightseeing)
 - ➤ host country pays for the transportation, entrance fees etc.
 - ➤ host families provide breakfast, dinner, or lunch package (if necessary)
 - > meal at school (lunch) should be provided by host families or could by supplied be hosting school
- ✓ Students staying in host families, teachers at hotels.
- ✓ Visiting students should send a basic information about themselves (sex, age, meal restrictions, allergies etc.).

3rd Project Meeting in Mjölby, Sweden

- <u>Date</u>: 25th 29th April, 2016 (2-3 working days), participating schools will check the flights and then we will decide the exact working days and the days of arrival and departure (deadline: 15th March, 2016)
- 4 students, 2 teachers from each country
- *Topic*: EU labour market



• <u>Tasks</u>: students of each country prepare a simple analysis of the labour market in their country on selected economic indicators and they will describe the conditions of entry of other EU citizens in their labour market (Swedish school will prepare a guideline what to include in the analysis and they will send the guideline to other schools – *deadline*: 15th December, 2015.)

Programme of the meeting:

- partners' presentations on the topic "EU labour market"
- workshop (international groups) discussing the most desirable positions, the necessary skills for different positions and professions and job opportunities for foreigners in the participating countries,
- workshop (international groups) a survey (the content to be specified) during the meeting the students (groups) will discuss what to incorporate in the survey (content still not clear needs to by clarified by Lenka Pacovská until 15th December, 2015), the survey = overview
- other points of the programme to be specified
- ✓ Students staying in host families, teachers if possible as well (hotels in Sweden very expensive).

4th Project Meeting in Košice, Slovakia

- 19th-20th October Trade Fair of local schools in Košice, partner schools as guests at the Fair (they can also participate in the Fair if they will be able to bring their "own companies" not compulsory)
