

Student Entrepreneurship in Europe (2015 – 2017)

EVALUATION

- 1) From March 2016 till the end of April 2016, during lessons of economics, foreign trade, English language and other economic subjects, students were gathering materials related to labour market in their countries, job opportunities in EU and the most desirable jobs at the current labour markets.
- 2) The content of the 3rd project meeting in Mjölby, Sweden (25th April – 29th April 2016) was to present Labour market in EU countries and each partner school and their 4 representing students prepared presentations comparing the situation on the labour market of Austria, the Czech Republic, Slovakia, Spain and Sweden. The presentations contained information about work skills needed for better employment, the most desirable jobs, salaries of selected professions, requirements for education etc.
- 3) During the workshop students worked in international groups on techniques for developing new business ideas. The groups also interviewed small local businessmen about the conditions for small businesses in the area and about advices for novice entrepreneurs.
- 4) At the end of the meeting, students evaluated the information and new knowledge obtained during the stay and during the work on presentations
- 5) Teachers meeting focused on feedback regarding accomplishing scheduled tasks and planning the next meeting in Košice, Slovakia in, October 2016, with the topic of „SWOT analysis“.
- 6) School coordinator of each partner organization was monitoring preparation of materials and gathering information to prepare a presentation of „SWOT analysis for farming and agricultural entrepreneurship in EU countries“.
- 7) As the main outcome of the project was to present students' training firms and to deepen their knowledge about entrepreneurship in EU, each school team was working on their training firms, its marketing plan, catalog, business cards etc.
