3rd Project Meeting in Mjölby, Sweden

- **Date: 25th – 29th April, 2016** (2-3 working days), participating schools will check the flights and then we will decide the exact working days and the days of arrival and departure (deadline: 15th March, 2016)
- 4 students, 2 teachers from each country
- **Topic:** EU labour market
- **Tasks:** students of each country prepare a simple analysis of the labour market in their country on selected economic indicators and they will describe the conditions of entry of other EU citizens in their labour market (Swedish school will prepare a guideline what to include in the analysis and they will send the guideline to other schools – *deadline:* 15th December, 2015.)

Programme of the meeting:

- partners' presentations on the topic „EU labour market“
- workshop (international groups) – discussing the most desirable positions, the necessary skills for different positions and professions and job opportunities for foreigners in the participating countries,
- workshop (international groups) – a survey (the content to be specified) – during the meeting the students (groups) will discuss what to incorporate in the survey (content still not clear – needs to be clarified by Lenka Pacovská – until 15th December, 2015), the survey = overview
- other points of the programme to be specified

Student Entrepreneurship in Europe 2015-2017

- ✓ Students staying in host families, teachers if possible as well (hotels in Sweden very expensive).
 - host country pays for the transportation, entrance fees etc.
 - host families provide breakfast, dinner, or lunch package (if necessary)
 - meal at school (lunch) should be provided by host families or could be supplied by hosting school

- ✓ Students staying in host families, teachers at hotels.

Prepare:

- **Students make a list of jobs they are interested in**
- **Rankin: most wanted jobs' survey at school in Austria + prepare a presentation**
- **Statistics: surplus / lack of jobs**
- **List requirements for the lacking jobs and the interesting jobs
(what skills should an entrepreneur have; what makes a good entrepreneur)**
