# WORK IN INTERNATIONAL GROUPS

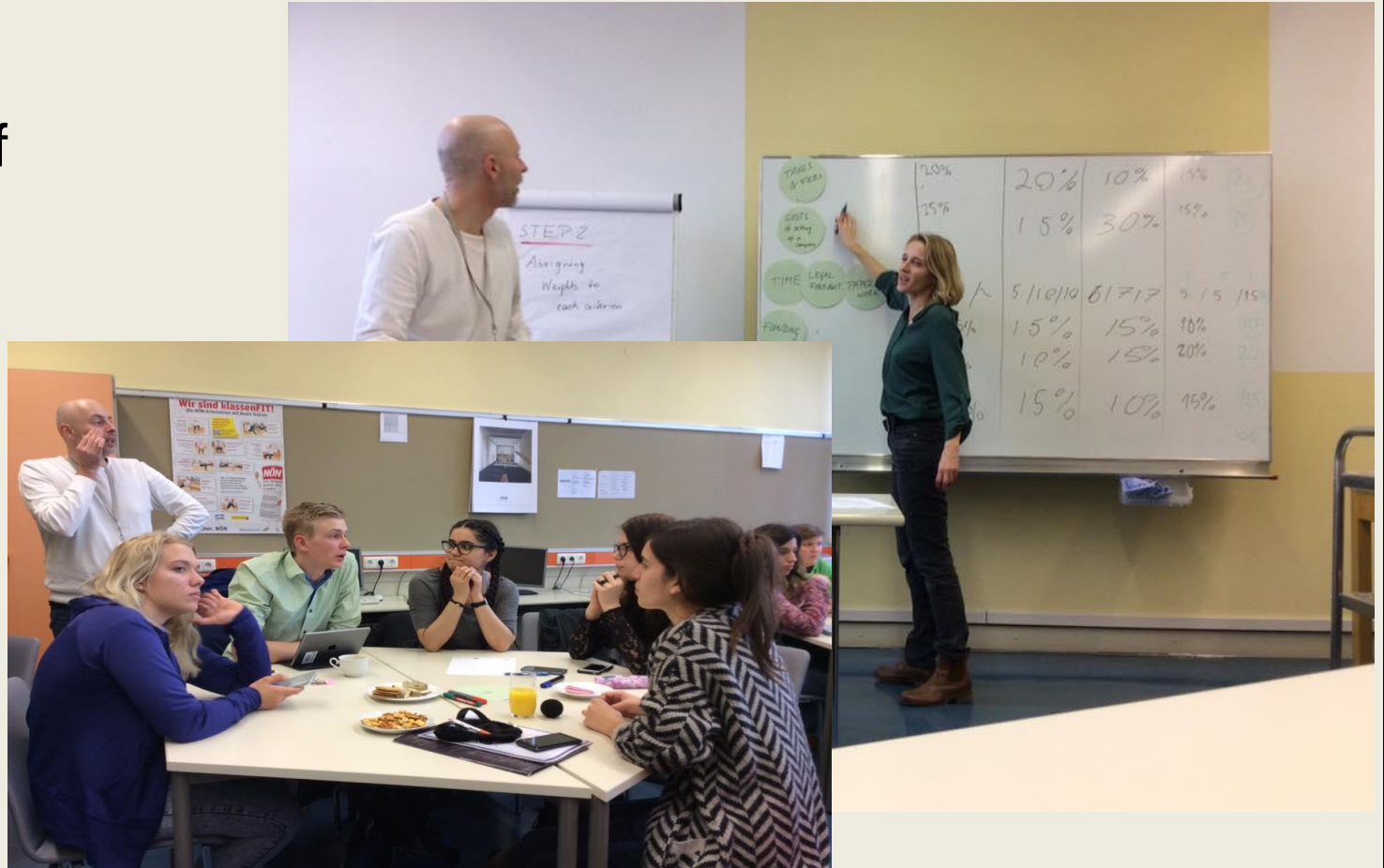
→ We were again divided into groups and discussed our opinions and insights.

## RATING & RESULTS

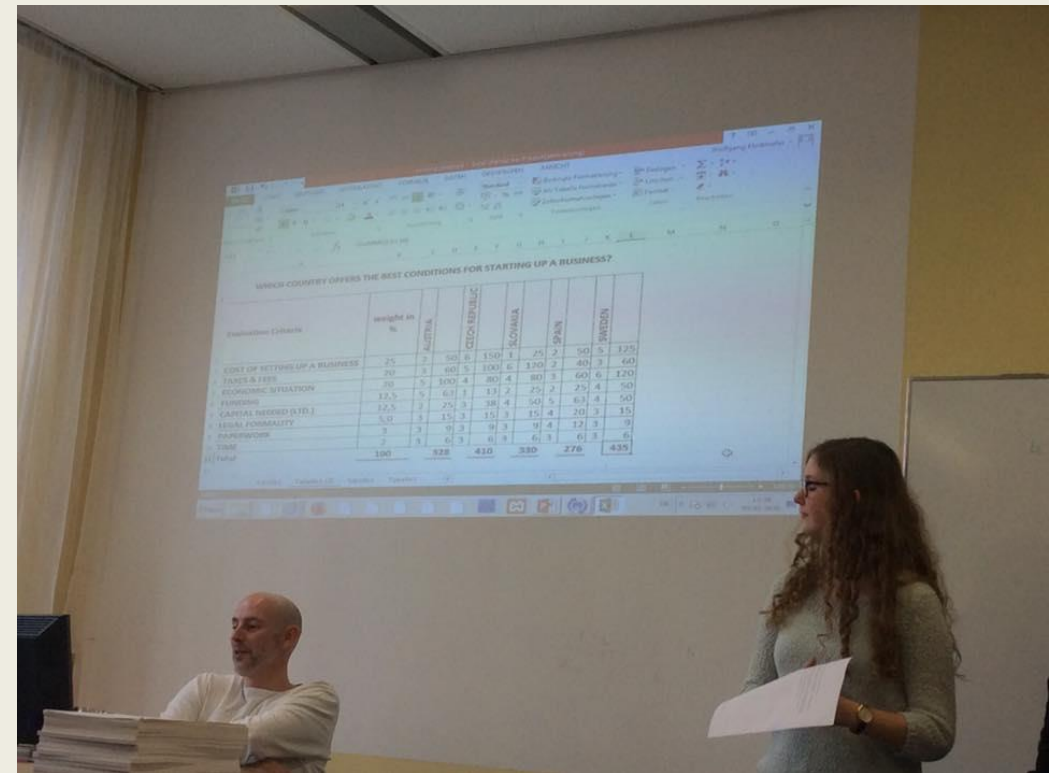
We discussed conditions of each country for starting up a business and rated it in order of which one was the best. Then we compared the results of each group.

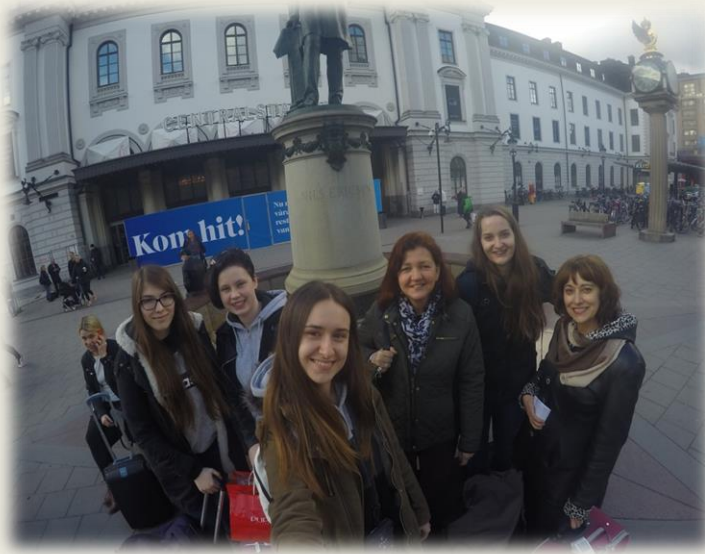


# Saturday

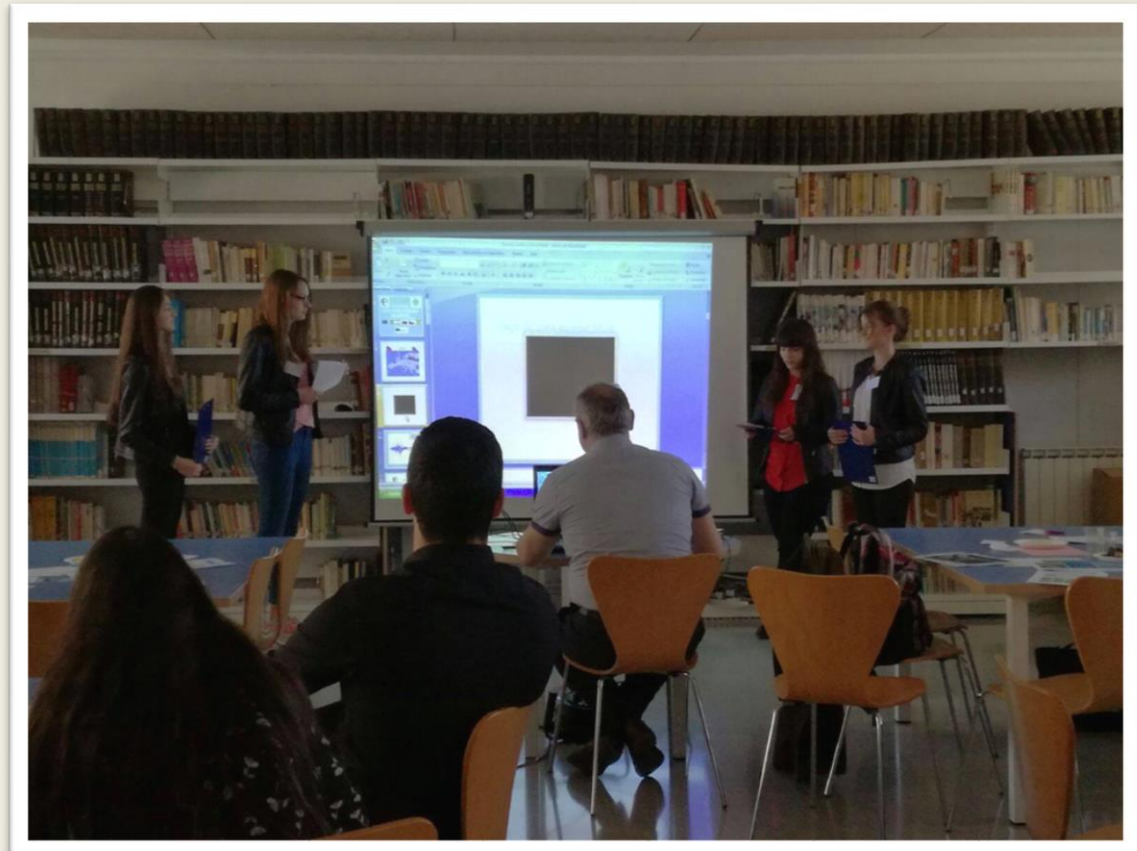
We were randomly divided into international groups. We were supposed to come up with a new marketing plan of a product and then present it to all the other groups.

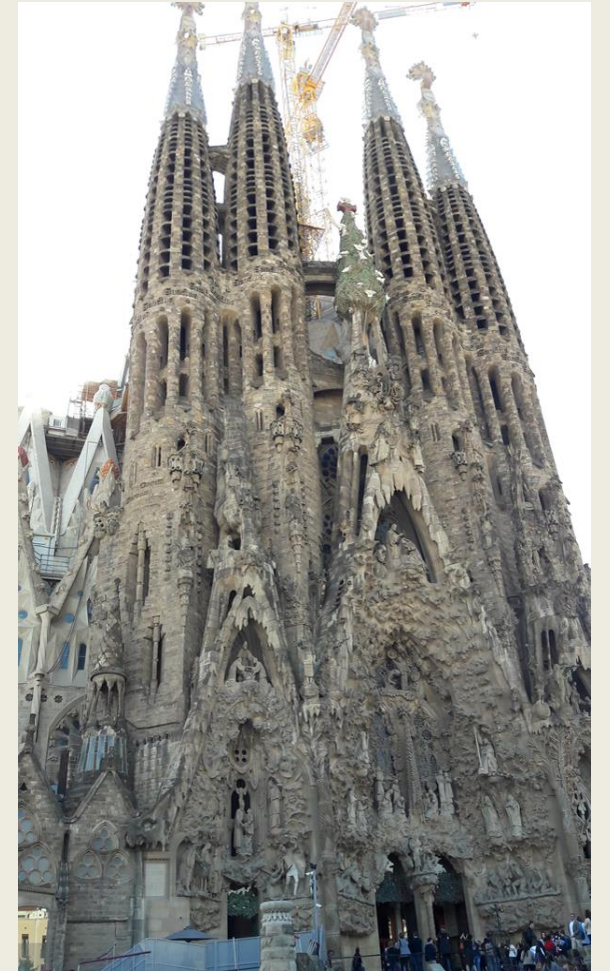
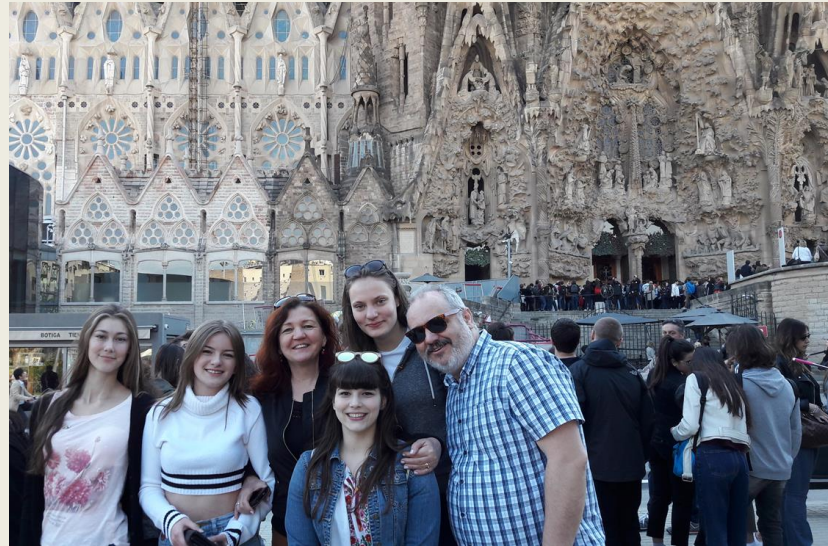




# Wednesday
