

### **History of Lithuania**


- The first known record of the name Lithuania was in year 1009.
- In 1253, Mindaugas was crowned. He was the first and only king in the Lithuanian history.
- In the 15th century, Lithuania was the biggest country in Europe - from the Baltic Sea to the Black Sea.
- In 1791, Lithuania adopted their first written constitution, which was the first constitution in Europe, and the second in the world.
