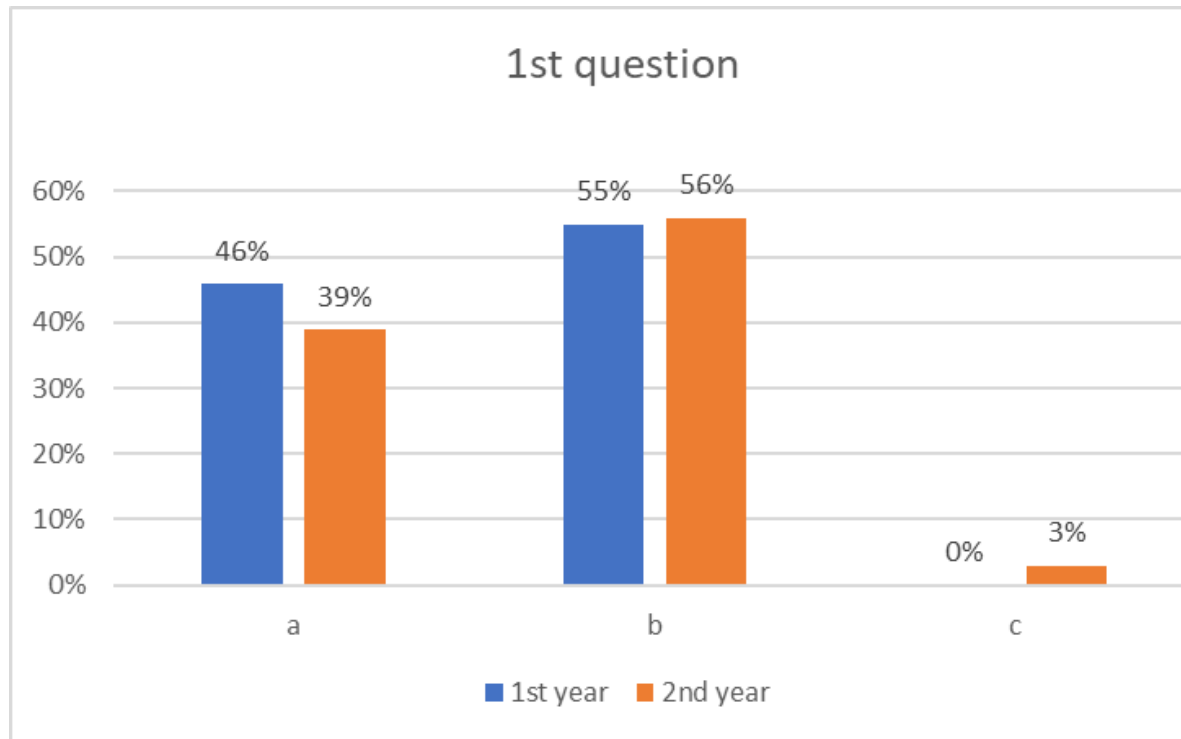

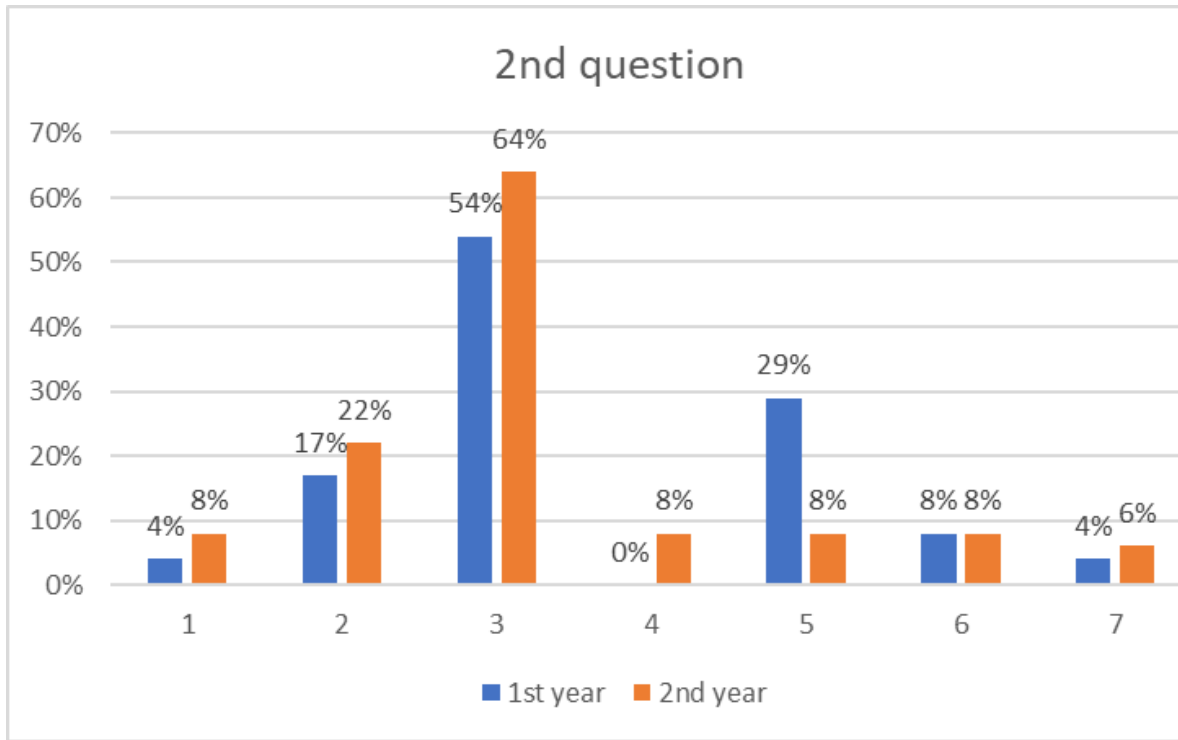
1st year – 24

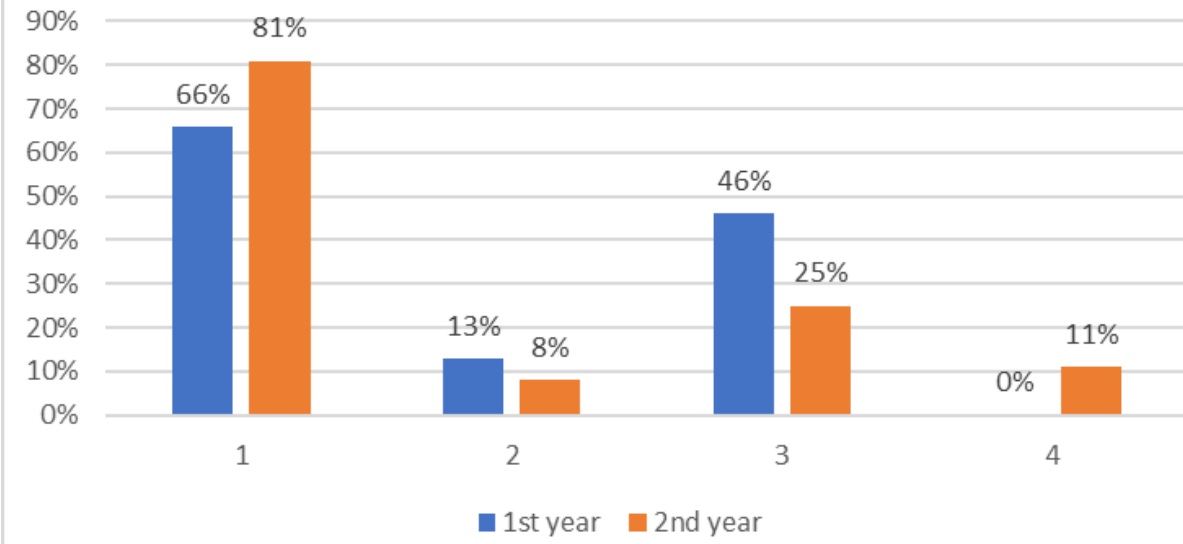
1) Did you know some information about the hosting country or the city?

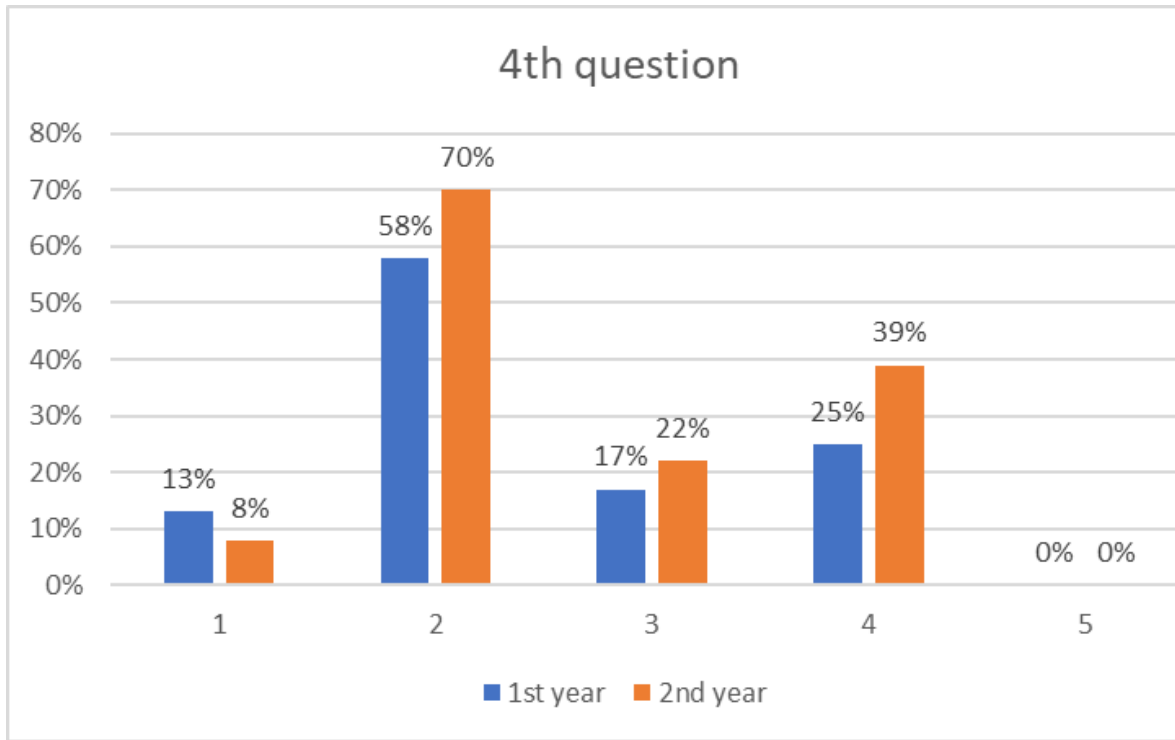
2) Were you afraid of anything before going to the meeting?

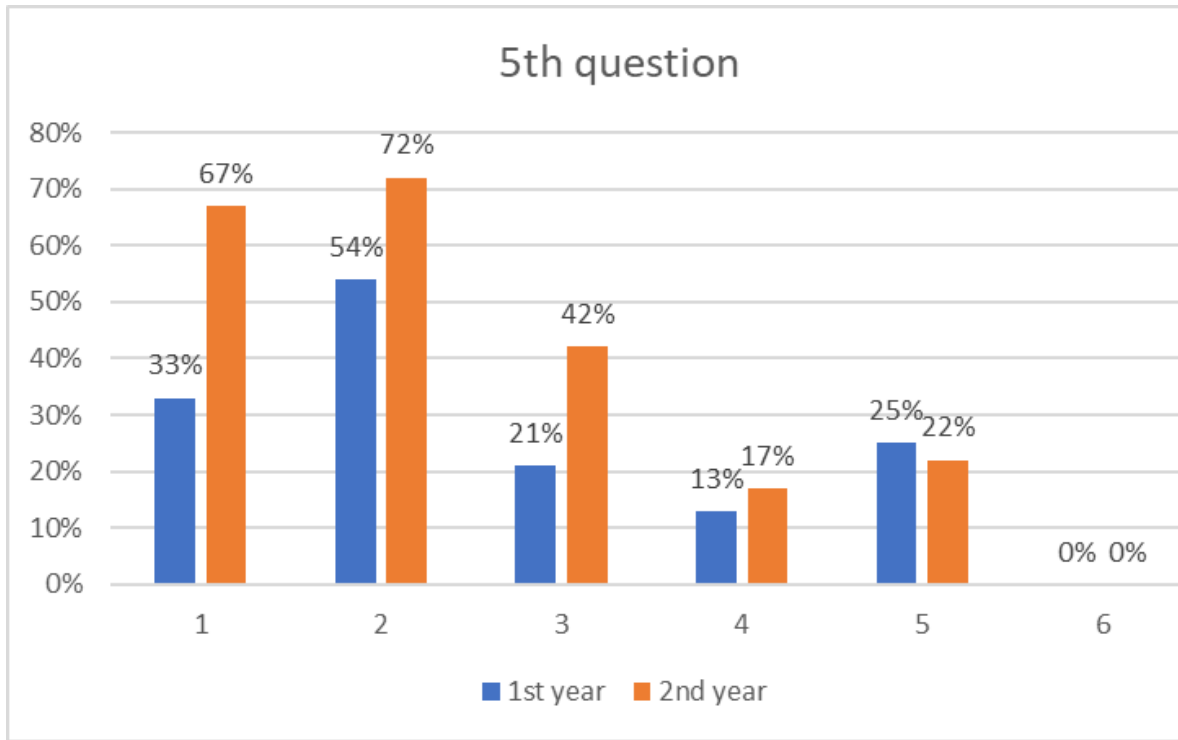

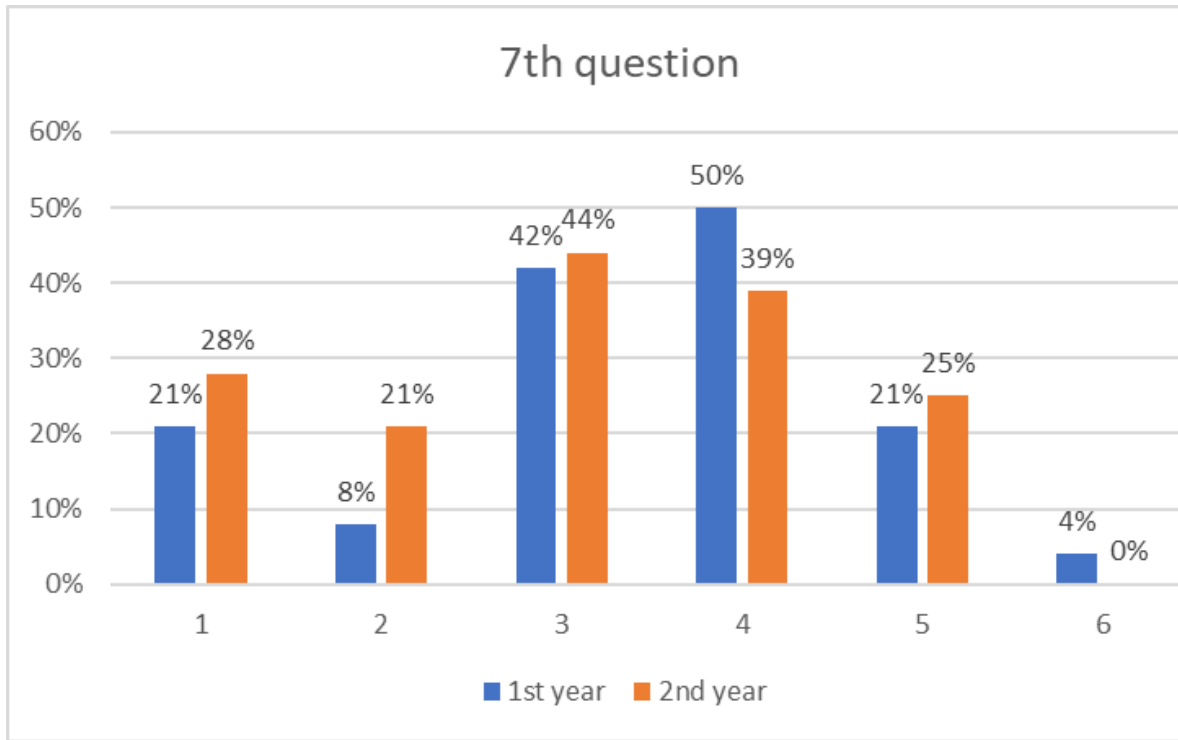
