

Portugal rejected 9 of the 64 articles of the Law 58/2019 of personal and data protection.



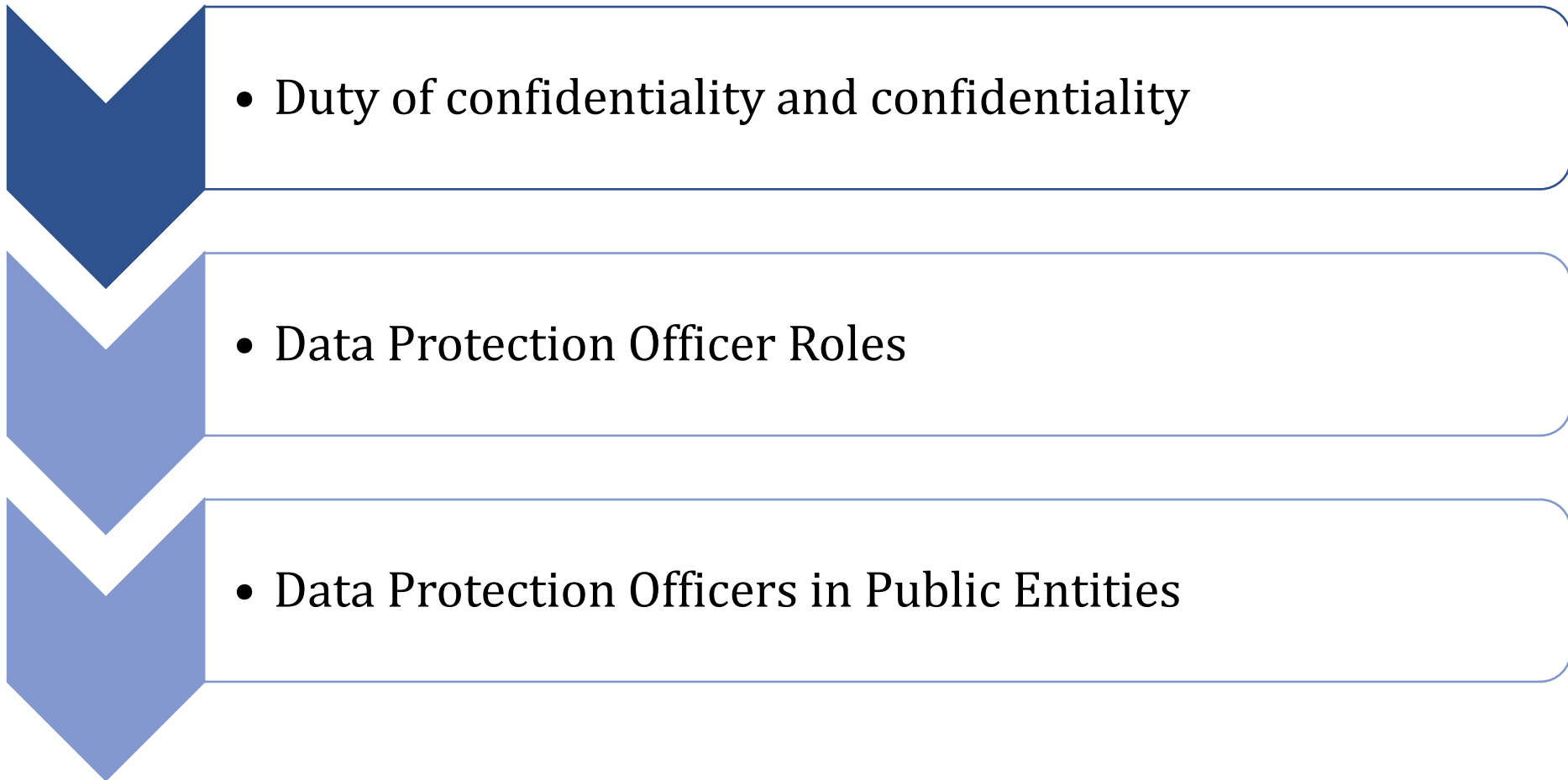
